

The Center ÜBERLEBEN has been treating victims of torture and war-time violence. About 500 People from nearly 50 countries around the world come to us to find help.

At the Center, men, women, adolescents and children receive medical and psychotherapeutic treatment as well as support from social workers.

Our multidisciplinary team works with specially trained interpreters supporting therapy sessions and transmitting cultural background .

In order for our patients to learn to live with the consequences of torture and violence, often a long-term and intensive treatment is necessary.

We raise awareness through a number of specialist publications, through lectures and conferences, networking with national and international organizations and committees as well as through our active press and public relations work. Internationally, we are involved in developing and building treatment centers in areas of conflict and persecution.



Since 2016 the Center ÜBERLEBEN continues to follow the work and mission of the Behandlungszentrum für Folteropfer (bzfo e.V.), which was founded in 1992.

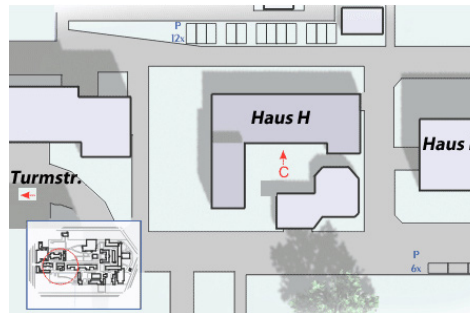

Our special library provides documentation and research into the health consequences of torture, persecution and extreme traumatization.

With more than 32.000 documents it is the **only library of its kind** in Germany on the subject of trauma and torture.

The **library catalog** encompasses over 30.000 data sets. Additionally we subscribe to about 100 journals.



Along with books, journals and newspaper articles **we also collect, prepare, and make accessible** congress materials, annual reports, brochures, audio and film recordings on the following subjects:

- diagnostics and treatment for torture and emotional trauma
- healthcare for traumatized refugees
- intercultural psychotherapy and psychiatry
- Survivors of extreme violence and victims of totalitarian regimes
